Meeting Minutes
November 2024

1. Call to Order

The regular monthly meeting of the Heath Township Board was called to order by Supervisor Ron Jones at 7:00 pm on November 11, 2024 at the Township Hall. Missy opened with prayer.

2. Roll Call

- F. B.Harvey will be meeting with Jeremy to look at power washing the fencing and barn at the Riverside Cemetery. Boerman requested that we set up the job to power wash the Park bathrooms in the Spring.
- G. Jones will discuss the new road that will be put in by the Elementary School with the Superintendent and neighbors to make sure everyone is aware of all the details.
- H. Commissioner Storey gave the County report. The Board thanked Jim for all his years of service to the County.

5. New Business

- A. Resident questioned about the new drain and where this project was at. She was directed to ask the Drain Commission about this.
- B. Resident questioned about the Hamilton Dam project and what information we had gotten for that. The Board stated we had not gotten anything back yet from Wightman Co.
